Lunch at the **Moeserer-Lake**, located in idyllic solitude of the Seefeld nature preserve.

DAY 3

Visiting the spectacular **Tyrolean museum at Bergisel**.

(360 degree portrayal of the 1809 battle for the Tyrolean liberation).

Experience the bird's eye view from the **Olympic ski-jumping tower**, overlooking the entire region.

Cableway to the **Hafelekar (Seegrube, 7000 feet)** with panoramic views of the Alps and the city of Innsbruck.

DAY 4

Traveling over the Brenner-Pass to South Tyrol (Northern Italy).

Visit of the historic old town of Brixen.

After lunch we will continue into the Dolomites region.

We will take a cable car to the Alm-Hut (Hotel) at **Col Raiser** in midst of the **Dolomites**, where their sheer rock walls are standing like silent stone sentinels against the sky.
